Eligibility:

- Open to Children and Youth Grades K-12.
- The contest will have four grade categories: Grades K-2, Grades 3-5, 6-8, and Grades 9-12.

Artwork Specifications:

- Artwork must pertain to the theme 'Bullying'.
- Artwork must be original two-dimensional work created by the student participant.
- Accepted mediums include drawing, painting, mixed media, digital art, and photography
- Maximum artwork size is 22" x 28".
- Artwork should not be framed.

Submission Process:

- Participants must submit a completed entry form with their artwork.
- Entries must be delivered to the Memphis Jewish Community Center.
- Student name, grade, and title of artwork should be well affixed to the back of the artwork.
- All entries must be submitted by September 18, 2026.

Entries that do not meet any of the above Submission Process parameters will not be accepted.

Judging and Awards:

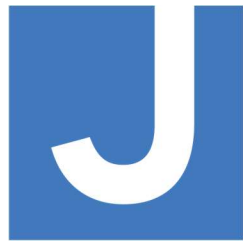
- A panel of local artists and art educators will judge artworks
- Entries will be evaluated on thematic appropriateness, creativity, technique, and overall artistic expression.
- Cash prizes will be awarded in each of the four grade categories.

Additional Rules

- Participants may only submit one artwork per person.
- Artworks must be the original work of the participant and not copied from other sources.
- The organizers reserve the right to reproduce accepted artworks for promotional purposes.
