Tu B'Shevat Youth Art Contest Guidelines

Eligibility:

- Open to Children and Youth Grades K-4.
- The contest will have two grade categories: Grades K-1 and Grades 2-4.

Artwork Specifications:

- Artwork must pertain to the Jewish holiday of Tu B'Shevat.
- Artwork must be two-dimensional and original work created by the participant.
- Accepted mediums include drawing, painting, mixed media, digital art, and photography.
- Maximum artwork size is 22" x 28".
- Artwork should not be framed.

Submission Process:

- Participants must submit a completed entry form with their artwork.
- Entries must be delivered to the **Memphis Jewish Community Center, Attn: CJLL**.
- All entries must be submitted by Friday, January 23, 2026. Late or incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- Student name and grade should be well affixed to the back of the artwork.
- Judging and Awards:
 - A panel comprised of local artists, art educators, and CJLL Committee Members will judge artworks.
 - Entries will be evaluated on creativity, technique, and overall artistic expression relating to the holiday.
 - Certificate prizes will be awarded in each of the two grade categories.

Additional Rules:

- Participants may only submit one artwork per person.
- Artworks must be the original work of the participant and not copied from other sources.
- The organizers reserve the right to reproduce accepted artworks for promotional purposes.
